<u>Agenda Item #4 - Financial Report:</u> Mr. Brohman asked Ms. Adams to pull up the Financial Report.

Mr. Brohman reviewed the financial report with the board. The numbers reflect the November 5, 2020 meeting discussion including Statements of Intent. No vote required.

Chairman Bowen asked for any public comments before proceeding into the discussion of reviewing the grants.

Mr. Wickersham addressed the board. Senator Julie Slama was recognized and she noted she had no comments and thought she needed to sign-in.

<u>Agenda Item #5 – Review Grants:</u> Discussion to clarify some questions proceeded the review process. The Grants Committee agreed 200 words for the description and 1200 words for the narrative was sufficient for the applicant and allowing attachments for additional information worked. The Grants Committee agreed to eliminate year 3 funds and consolidated in years 1 and 2 some of the funds requested in year 3 and in some cases eliminate year 3 funding. The exception is the Department of Natural Resources application, noted in Statutes, receives funding in year 3. Chairman Bowen led the discussion on the list of all grant applications, with the exception of equipment grants, discussed at the November 5, 2020 meeting.
