Nebraska Environmental Trust to Hold Listening Sessions for Title 137 Rules and Regulations Governing Activities of the Nebraska Environmental Trust

The Nebraska Environmental Trust (NET) will hold four listening sessions for any proposed ideas to change Title 137 Rules and Regulations Governing Activities of the Nebraska Environmental Trust. These listening sessions are intended for grant applicants and stakeholders, as well as the general public. Both in-person and virtual attendance options will be available.

About the meeting: The purpose of these meetings is to provide public input as the NET Board considers updating Title 137, Rules and Regulations Governing Activities of the Nebraska Environmental Trust with a comprehensive restructuring of the regulation format to streamline and clarify existing provisions including language modernization. Attendees are highly encouraged to submit questions and comments. NET is conducting the outreach efforts so that any informal comments received by the NET Title 137 Committee and staff from the public can be evaluated and incorporated when possible to present to the NET Board for consideration.
